## **Eligibility Requirements**

---

Selection will be based on applicant's ability to fulfill and show proof of the following qualifications:

- a. Be 18 years of age or older and a District of Columbia resident
- b. Ability to complete a 12-week course; 5 p.m. to 9 p.m., Monday – Thursday
- c. Earn a CASAS (Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment Systems) math and reading assessment at a 6<sup>th</sup> grade or higher level
- d. Access to reliable transportation to come to training
- e. Must pass an initial drug screening and remain drug free
- f. Must be able to stand for long periods of time and work in confined (small) spaces, lift, push, pull or carry 50 pounds
- g. Unemployed, low income or other barriers to securing employment
- h. High School Diploma preferred; not required

## **Starting a new career is only three steps away**

1. Gather/obtain ALL "required" documentation (see list below)
2. Attend and bring all required documentation to a intake session
3. Meet eligibility requirements

- Proof of eligibility to work in the U.S. (e.g., Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, Passport, Work VISA, etc.)
- Valid DC Government issued Photo ID
- Original DC Police Report (dated within 60 days of intake session)
